Let's float an idea – a trial balloon. There has been some chatter about the possibility of creating "Family Days" (not sure what to call it) for Pleasant Chapel.

- This is a step at sustaining Pleasant Chapel. We do need more young people and families to ensure that the work of Pleasant Chapel can go on for years to come. Developing a time and space where new people can come and get connected with God with this family is what we are supposed to be doing.

We would want to be sure that we are planning events that would not conflict with any of the current programs we have like the tenderloin supper, the soup supper, VBS, etc.

I think there is a great opportunity for "the next generation" to do the leg work on this. I think it would be wise to get several of our congregation who have young children to be the planners of Family Days. That is not to say those people have to do all the work, but perhaps we could create a team of parents and our youth leaders to begin to plan some of these events. For sure everyone is welcome to the events, it simply makes sense for our youth leaders and younger parents to plan the events.

We would love to know what you think about this and especially if you would be willing to help be part of the planning!
