PC Women's Group

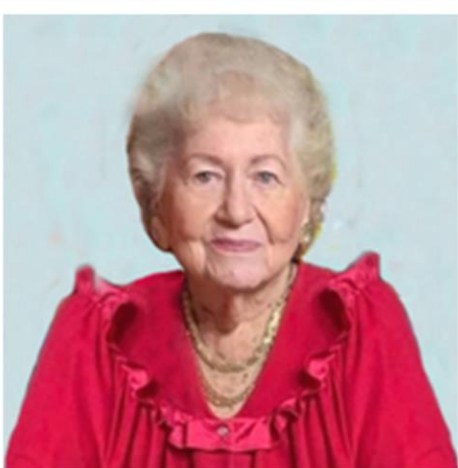

Olean began her work career at Ion Capacitors, Columbia City then Memcor in Huntington where she had 25 years of service retiring in 1990.

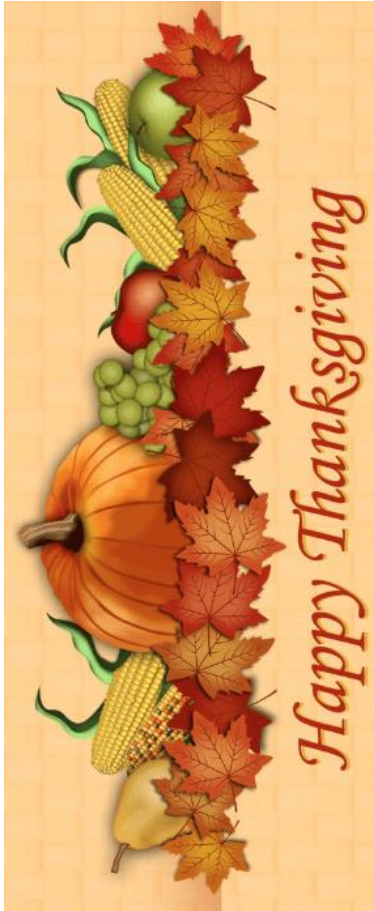
- Term ending year indicates the last year of service – for example those listed in 2023 go off of that committee at the end of 2023.
