A Little Dreaming

The Building Committee continues to work on developing some possible improvements to the existing PC building.


Currently the committee has developed some rough sketches of a facility that provide ground level commons area for large gatherings, meeting areas, and easier access to the sanctuary. Larger sketches are printed and are at the back of the church to view.

These sketches are being sent to builders and designers for them to provide a more detailed drawing and cost estimates. The sketches are also for YOU to look at, consider, and discuss.

We are far from making any decision to build or not to build. Here is how the Executive Board has ordered the process.

- 1. The Executive Board created a building committee to explore possible building plans and present those options to the Board.
- 2. The Building Committee visits area churches with similar structures, considers our current needs and wants, and acquires proposals with budgetary estimates.
- 3. The Building Committee submits the proposals to the Executive Board for consideration.
- 4. If the Board chooses to move forward, there will be lots of opportunity for discussion and input. A lot of details will need worked out

such as if any additional land needs to be acquired, septic system requirements, how to finance, etc. Clearly this is a big proposal, and it is vital that the church continue to seek God's will for this and all ministry opportunities of the church.





5. Eventually a Congregational Conference (church member meeting) would be held to discuss and vote on a proposal. The church would then vote to choose to build or not to build.


We are currently at step #2, we have a long way to go in the process.


