Thank you, Leona.

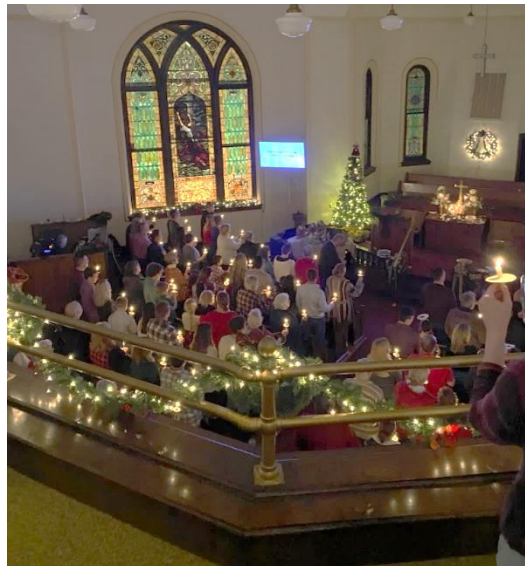
A great Christmas Eve's Eve service. It was good to see many
